



Code of Conduct – Young Players (U18's)

All players have a responsibility to behave appropriately and reflect the values of the game and our club Pembroke CC on and off the field of play.

All young players and their parents and guardians should read the Spirit of Cricket which underpins the Code of cricket. See attached.

Please remember that nearly everyone you will engage with, coaches, umpires' scorers' managers are all volunteers. Without them there would be no games. Please always respect them.

Before the game.

- Make sure you attend all your training sessions and let you manager know if you can't attend.
- Turn up on time for all coaching and matches.
- Make sure you have all your cricket gear with you.
- Remember phones must be put in valuables bag for durations of all training sessions and matches.
- Understand that coaches are there to help you improve your skills. It is very important that you listen to them and follow their instructions.

During the game.

- Always play by the rules
- try your best and play fair.
- Never argue with an Umpire, Scorer, or another player during a match. If you disagree with a decision, bring it to the attention of your Coach or manager in a break in the game or after the match.
- Never deliberately try to put another player off their game but saying or doing anything to upset them.
- Remember you are part of a team, and everyone's contributions counts. Always put in your best effort of yourself and your team.
- Be a good sport and always applaud other players even opposing team's good play.

After the game.

- Always shake hands with your opposing team
- Never leave the field without thanking the umpires, scorers, and coaches.
- Tidy away any ropes or cones as instructed.
- Please take all your cricket gear home
- Put your rubbish in a bin and if no bin available bring it home with you.
